

**FIRE PIT STANDARDS FOR MOGOLLON RANCH**  
**Approved September 9, 2006**

Fires are not permitted except in an approved fire pit.

All fire pits must be inspected and approved by the Blue Ridge Fire Department prior to use. If you have questions concerning your pit, please call the Fire Department at 928.477.2751.

A fire pit must be constructed of insulated fire bricks on the floor with rocks, bricks or 3/16" thick steel ring around the sides.

The diameter must not be greater than four (4) feet.

The pit must be located a minimum of twenty five (25) feet from any combustible material, such as trees, structures, wood piles, propane tanks, pine needles, forest debris, oak leaves, etc.

The flame must not exceed three (3) feet at any time.

No slash, needle, leave or forest debris burning as a form of clearing is allowed in the fire pit.

Water must be available via a garden hose at all times.

A designated person must be in attendance when the pit is in use.

The Fire Department shall have the authority to prohibit fire pit burning as they determine in keeping with the Fire District Policy and Coconino County restrictions. A red flag will be placed at the entrance of Mogollon Ranch indicating to the residents and their guests when no fires are allowed at this time.

Violation of this burning policy in Mogollon Ranch constitutes a \$10,000 fine.

The residents of Mogollon Ranch must have their existing fire pits approved by the Fire Department no later than November 1, 2006. Please send a copy of Fire District Approval to:
